Change from Track and Trigger to NEWS 2

In 2019, Track and Trigger will be changing to NEWS 2. Exact date to be confirmed once Ward/Team Champions have been provided with training resources.

Phase 1: ISD Inpatient Wards

- Completed October 2018. The process is well embedded in these wards, audit to be undertaken 2019

Phase 2: Inpatient AMH, OPMH, LD and Specialised Services (excl. Bluebird and Leigh House)

- NEWS 2 Ward Champions to be trained between February and April 2019, training to be cascaded to all Ward Staff who undertake physical observations as part of their roll. Rollout scheduled for quarter 2, 2019. **PLEASE DO NOT ROLL THIS OUT INDEPENDENTLY, THE WARD MANAGERS WILL RECEIVE DIRECT INSTRUCTION FROM KERRY LEWIS – RESUSCITATION OFFICER ON WHAT DATE TO ROLLOUT. CONTINUE TO USE TRACK AND TRIGGER TOOL TO RECORD PHYSICAL OBSERVATIONS UNTIL THIS TIME.**

Phase 3: Community Teams

- This phase is being planned at present. Update to be provided in May 2019 **PLEASE DO NOT ROLL THIS OUT INDEPENDENTLY, THE TEAM MANAGERS WILL RECEIVE DIRECT INSTRUCTION FROM KERRY LEWIS – RESUSCITATION OFFICER ON WHAT DATE TO ROLLOUT. CONTINUE TO USE TRACK AND TRIGGER TOOL TO RECORD PHYSICAL OBSERVATIONS UNTIL THIS TIME.**
